# ENVIRONMENT

Sanitize spaces before & after arrival/dismissal

Use areas that allow 6' physical distance

Clean & disinfect all areas

**Reassess use of facility**

### **BEHAVIOR**

Require cloth face coverings

Take temperatures

Provide pastoral care to congregation

**Reassess protocols** 

## **CONTACT TRACING**

Establish an attendance system for any facility use

Communicate with all participants who were on site & potentially exposed while maintaining confidentiality

Update Emergency Operations Plan to include COVID-19 protocols

> Plan for when a staff or congregant gets sick

Encourage testing & quarantining for 14 days.

#### **GREATER GOOD**

Know the numbers in your county: dph.georgia.gov/covid-19-daily-status-report

> Identify the contact information for your local public health department

Inform congregation of exposure and updated facility use policy.

Report case & potential outbreak to your local public health department
