Policy Regarding Languages

At any stage in the process, including Inquiry, Candidacy, and Final Assessment, students, particularly those for whom English is not their first language, may choose to write their paperwork in their primary language, then have it translated by a certified translator. Both the original document and the translated document must be submitted at the regular deadline.

Once a Candidate reaches Final Assessment, the Committee on Preparation for Ministry will cover up to 50% of the cost of translation services.

In addition, students are also welcome to bring a non-family Interpreter to each CPM meeting to aid in the discussion. Recommendations can be provided if requested by the student.
